


# VICE PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE





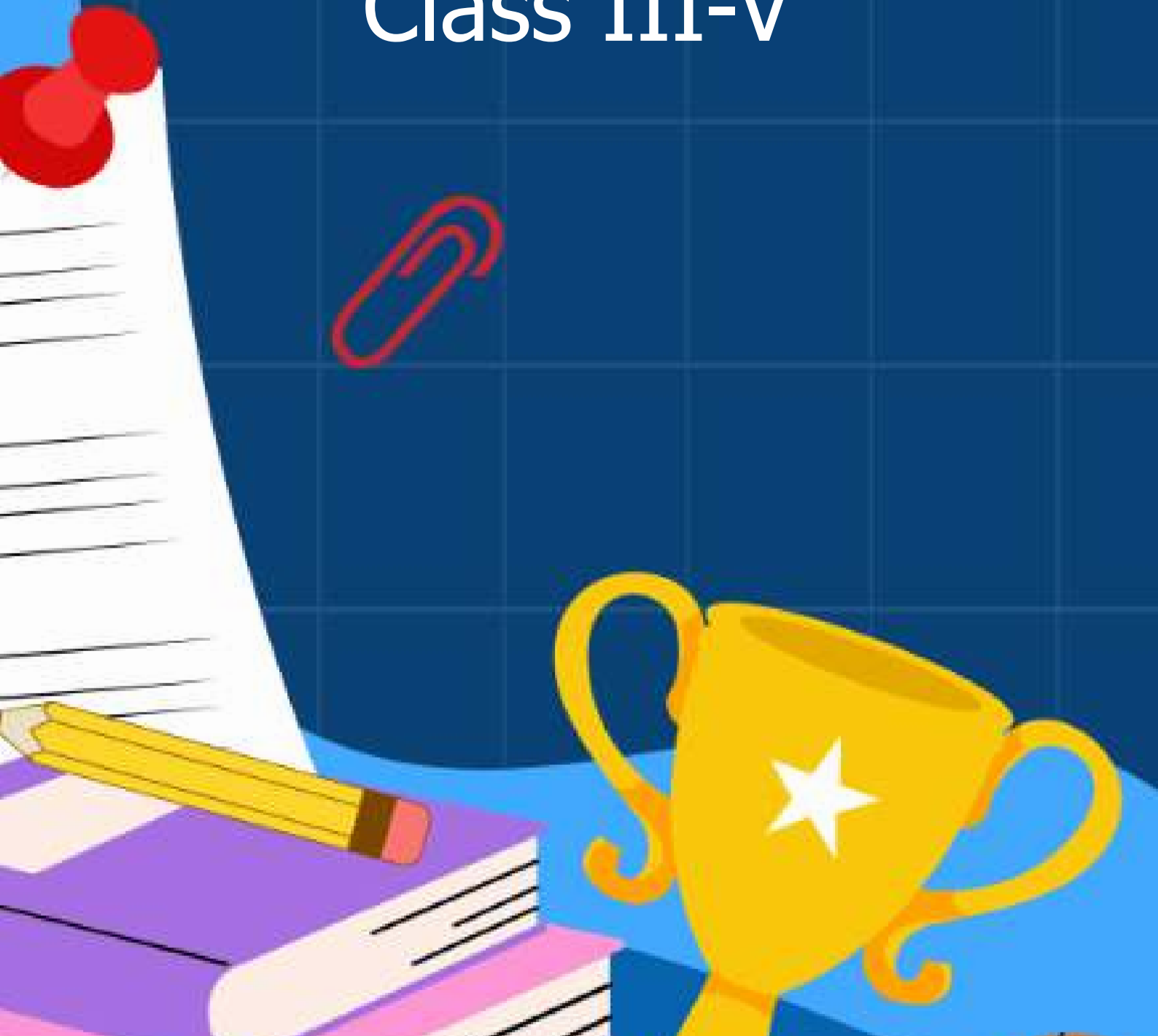

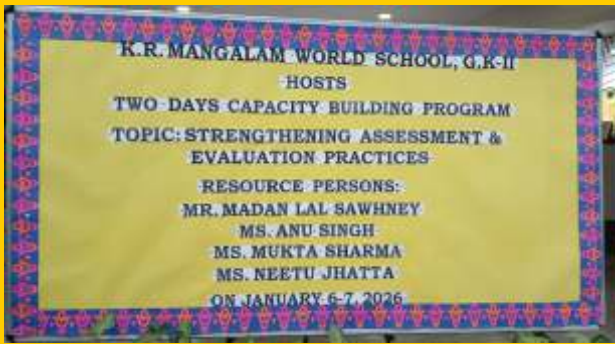
## Inter-School Tournament – A Stellar Performance

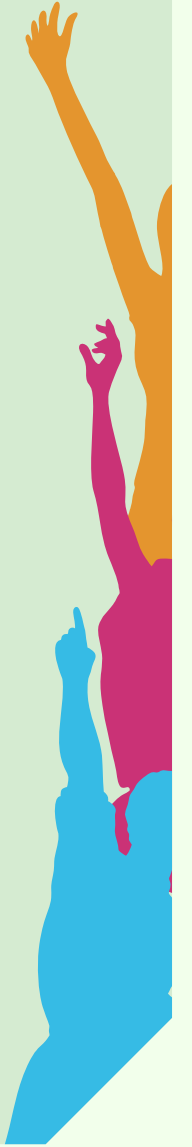

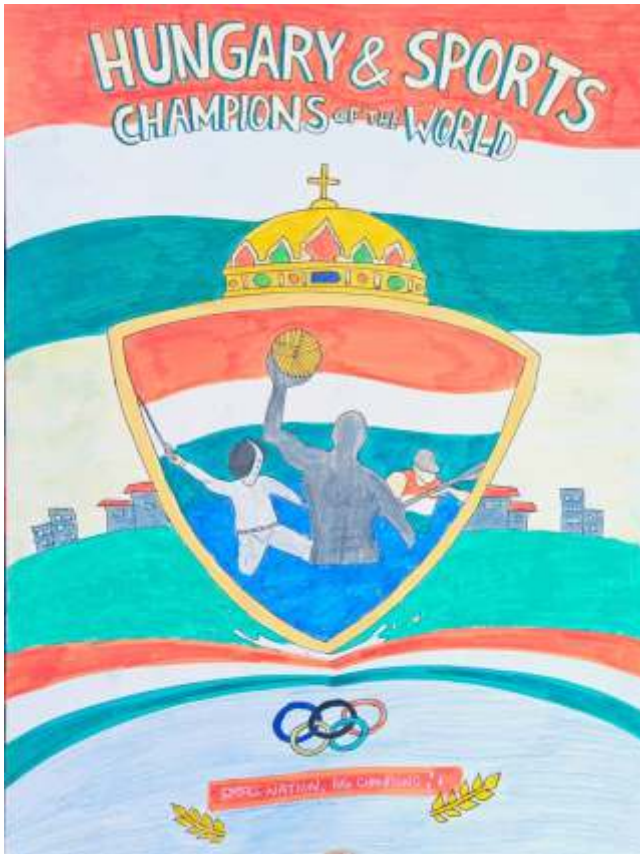
## National Youth Day – Inspiring Young Minds

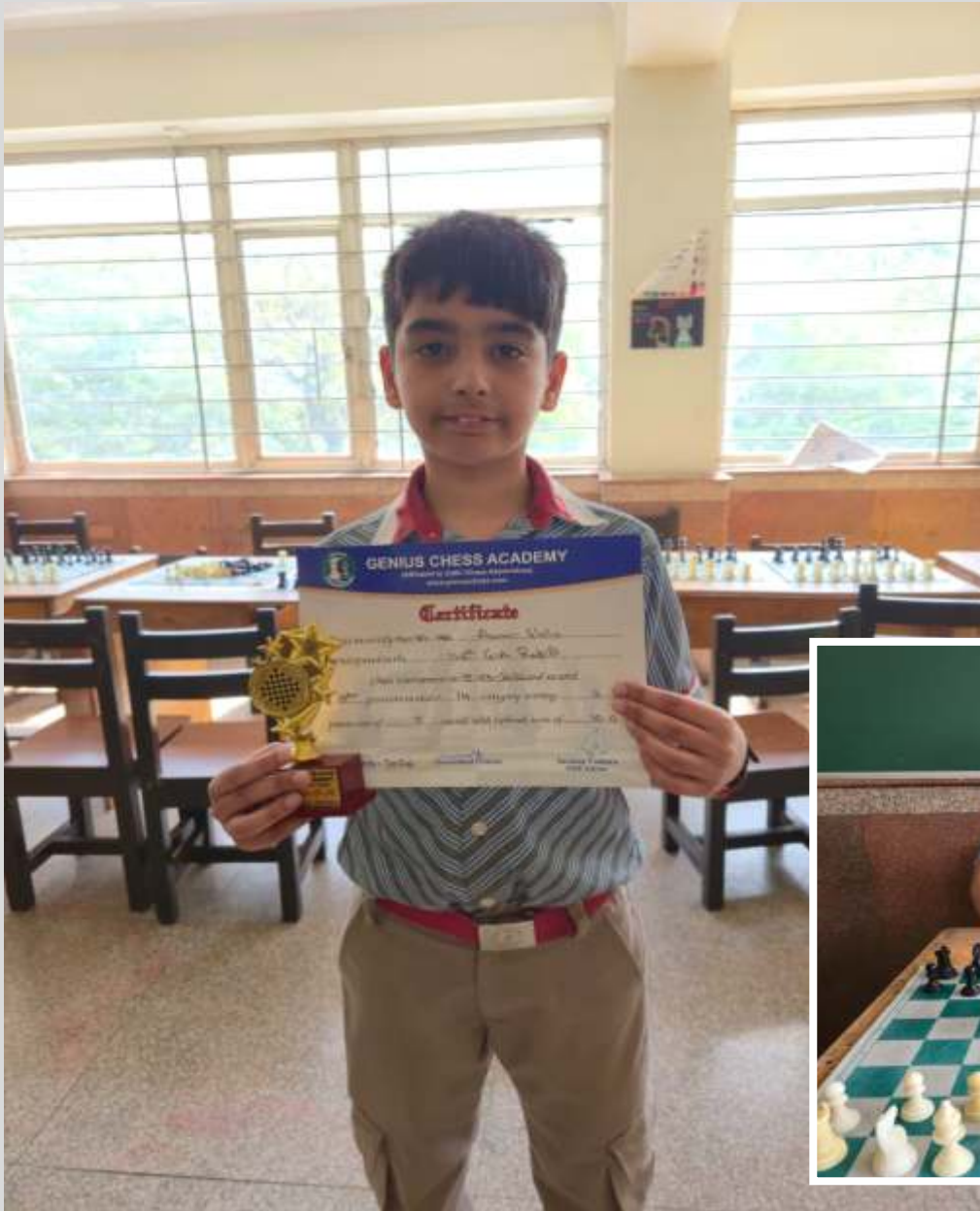
## Class VIII A Clean Water and Sanitation

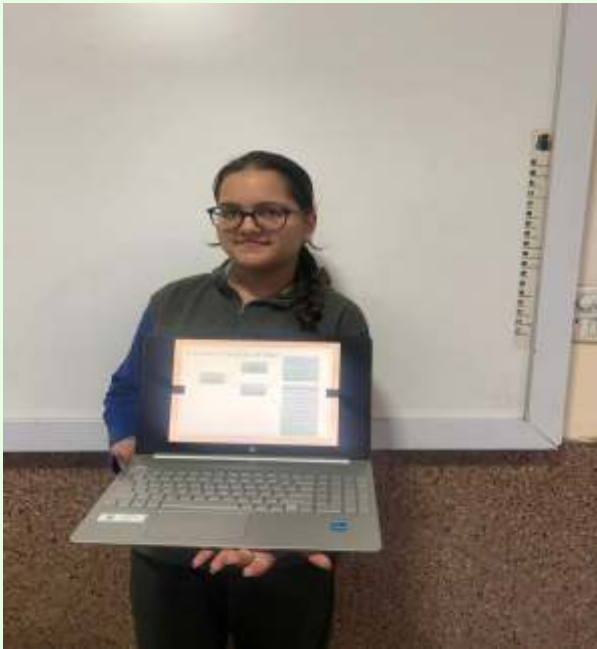
## Class XII-D Assembly Quality Education (SDG-4)

## PREPARATIONS IN FULL SWING ....

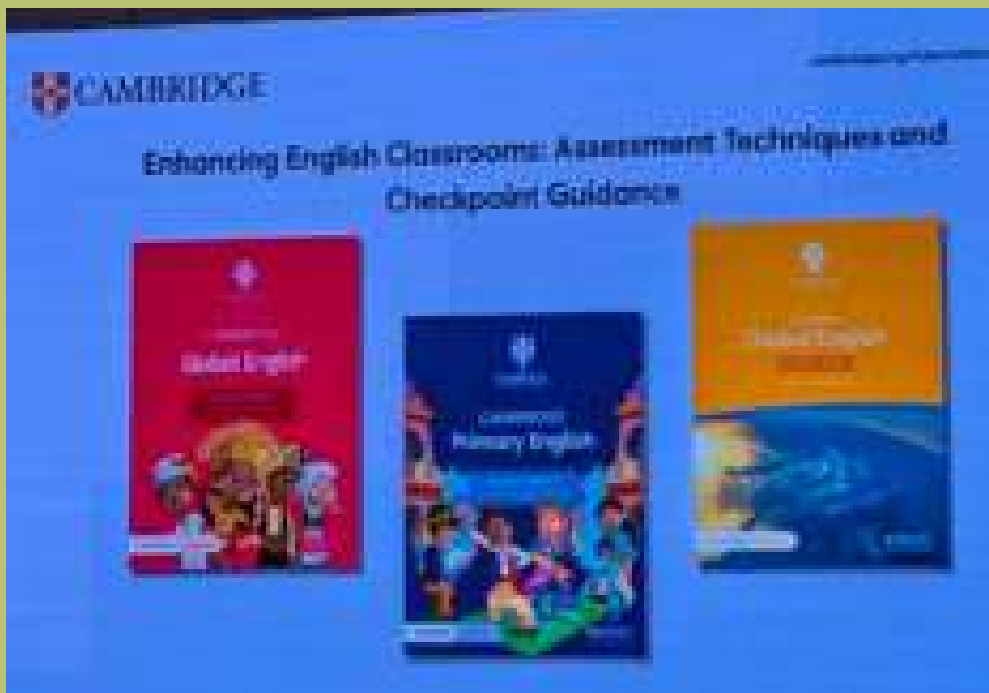

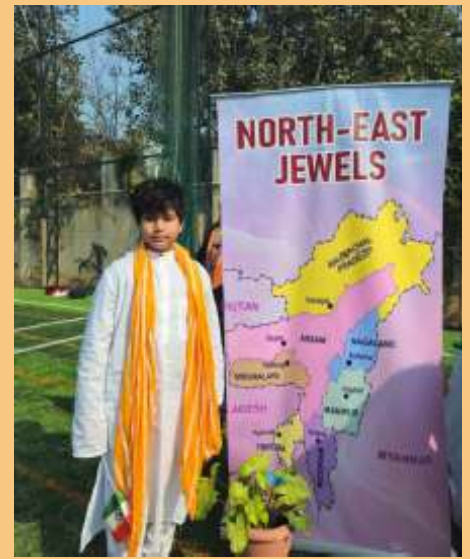

## COUNSELLING SESSION

## ACADEMICS

## VISIT TO AAPNO GHAR

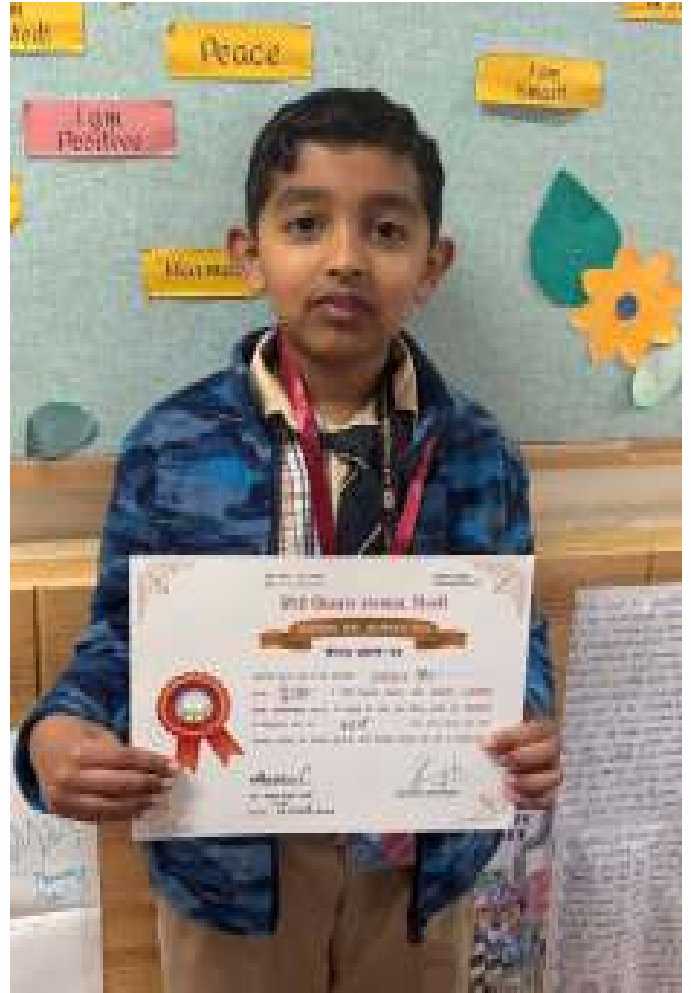
The students of Grade 1 went to Aapno Ghar for a fun and enjoyable trip. The children were very excited to travel with their friends and teachers.
